Exhibitions Opportunity for Graduate Students

Participation: This exhibition is open to twenty-five graduate level students world wide currently enrolled in an academic program working in any print medium.

Description: How will we navigate the increasingly complex, interrelated political, economic or social conditions of our global future? What are current trends that should be paid attention to?

Directional signage attracts attention to, establishes identities or communicates instructions to a fast paced moving public. Signs of the Times exhibition will utilize the inherent qualities of directional signage. Each participant will identify a current political, religious, cultural or economic issue to bring to the public's attention.

Working in your preferred printmaking processes (etching, relief, lithography or screen – Digital elements are welcome in connection with other processes) participating artists will submit images in digital format to be reproduced on industrial blank signage (format: approx. 18"x24" rectangle, circle, crossing, triangle or octagon shaped) that will be posted along walking and traffic routes around the conference site.
